1. General information.

1. The Operator of <https://vivalid.io> is **VIVALID OU** with its seat in Tallinn, Estonia (court register number 14425594).
2. The Service obtains information about users and their activities in the following manner:
 - a. The information voluntarily provided by User in the forms
 - b. Technical logs recorded at the WWW server level operated by VIVALID OU that runs a website available at <https://vivalid.io>.
3. This Policy is for informational purposes only and does not substitute the security policy kept by the Service Operator in compliance with the personal data protection provisions and General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679).
4. With respect to data that are personal data, in light of the Personal Data Protection Act, the data administrator shall be the Service Operator.

2. INFORMATION IN THE FORMS.

1. The Service collects the information provided voluntarily by the user: name and surname, sex, email address, residential address, IP address, location data.
2. User has the right to request for discontinuing of his personal data procession and to be forgotten in accordance with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679). The abovementioned request is based upon a request sending it to: contact@vivalid.io.
3. The Service may also record the information about the connection parameters (time stamp, IP address).
4. The data provided in the form shall not be made available to any third parties in any other manner.
5. If the data provided in the form may constitute a set of personal data, then such set shall be recorded by the Service Operator according to Estonian law.
6. If the data provided in the form allow identification of a natural person, then such person shall be authorized to view, modify and demand cease of further processing of his/her data at any time. However, it may deactivate some of the Service functions.

7. Personal data procession is based upon consent of the User expressed in the form contact@vivalid.io.
8. The data provided in the form are processed for the purposes outlined in a given form, e.g. in order to provide the information services.

3. INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES.

1. The Service uses cookies.
2. The cookies files are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the terminal device of the Service User and intended for the use of the Service websites. Such files usually include the name of their original website, their storage time in the terminal device and the unique number.
3. The Service Operator or entities working therewith manage and receive all cookies in the terminal device of the Service User.
4. The cookies files are used for the purpose to create statistics that provide essential information on how the Service Users use different websites, which allows to improve their structure and content.
5. The browser software (Internet browser) usually allows to storing cookies in the terminal device of the Service User by default. The Service Users may change the settings in that respect. The Internet browser allows to remove cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. The detailed information may be found in the Help section or in the documentation of the Internet browser.
6. The restrictions on cookies may affect some functionalities available on the Service websites.
7. The cookies files stored in the terminal device of the Service User may also be used by the advertisers and partners working with the Service Operator as well as payment providers.
8. We strongly advise you to read the privacy policy of such companies in order to be aware of the rules of using cookies for the statistical purposes: Google Analytics Privacy Policy.

4. SERVER LOGS.

1. The information on some users' activities is subject to logging in the server layer. Such data are only used for the administration purposes and to ensure the best quality of the rendered IT services.
2. The viewed resources are identified through URL addresses. Furthermore, the following information may be stored:
 - a. time of query
 - b. time of reply
 - c. name of client's station - identification made through HTTP protocol
 - d. information about errors that occurred during the HTTP transaction
 - e. URL address of the website previously visited by the user (referrer link) - in case when the User was directed to the Service by a link
 - f. information about the User's browser
 - g. information about IP address.
3. The above data are not associated with particular persons who visit certain websites.

5. DISCLOSING AND OUTSOURCING OF DATA PROCESSING

1. The data are subject to disclosure to external entities exclusively within the legally permitted limits.
2. The Operator may be obliged to disclose the information collected by the Service to the bodies authorized on the basis of the tasks as resulting from the task, which are in conformity with the provisions of law.

6. MANAGEMENT OF COOKIES - HOW TO GIVE OR REVOKE CONSENT IN PRACTICE?

1. If the user does not wish to receive cookies, he/she may change the browser settings.
2. In order to manage the cookies settings, select browser/ system from the list below and follow the instructions:
 - a. Internet Explorer
 - b. Chrome
 - c. Safari
 - d. Firefox
 - e. Opera
 - f. Android
 - g. Safari (iOS)
 - h. Windows Phone
 - i. Blackberry

7. STATEMENT

1. VIVALID declares that it does not transfer users' data to third parties nor does it carry out user profiling for marketing purposes.
2. VIVALID may, under current EU and Estonian law, transfer users' personal data to state administration authorities; in particular, in case of existence of a suspected violation of law.

8. AN IDENTITY DOCUMENTS

1. The user at the time of uploading of a copy of an identity document via internet agrees to the use and processing of the copy of the document by VIVALID in order to register and verify data compliance.
2. The user at the time of uploading of a copy of the document via internet agrees to send the copy of the document outside the area governed by the law of Estonia, especially to Poland.

9. LAW AND JURISDICTION

This policy is governed by Estonian law.
